

# What we know the NSA can do:

- It can access your email, chat, web browsing history, and text messages; can track the numbers of both parties on a phone call, as well location, time and duration.
- It can map your social networks, and monitors communication in online games.
- It can spy on foreign leaders' cell phones, hack into the UN, and go undercover within embassies to have closer access to foreign networks.
- It can physically intercept deliveries, open packages, and make changes to devices; can install fake SIM cards to then control a cell phone, and can even install devices by which they can access a computer that isn't connected to the Internet.
- It can tap into the links between Google and Yahoo data centers to collect email and other data, intercept communications between aircraft and airports, and can set up listening posts on the roofs of buildings to monitor communications in a city.
- It can access your smartphone app data, can intercept phone calls by setting up fake base stations, and can remotely access a computer by setting up a fake wireless connection and It can crack cellphone encryption codes.
- It can track bank transactions. (!!!)
